TAX CREDITS:

- **O** Charitable and political donation receipts
- O Medical/dental/attendant care expenses
- O If aged 70 or older during 2023, medical/dental/attendant expenses for Ontario Seniors Care at Home Tax Credit
- O Tuition fee receipt (T2202) for self, or with dependent's income and signatures
- O Disability credit form (T2201) for self or dependents for first-time claims
- **O** Student loan interest statement
- O Adoption costs
- **O** Names and birthdates for children under age 18
- For seniors or disabled individuals residing on their own, or with family members, receipts for home renovations to improve accessibility (increased to maximum of \$20,000 in 2023)
- **O** Receipts for monthly transit passes (for seniors only)
- O Indicate if eligible for first-time home buyer credit for 2023
- Indicate if infirm family member (other than child) resides with you or is dependent on you, along with dependent's net income
- O For teachers, eligible teaching supplies bought during 2023
- O Maximum employment deduction for tradespeople/apprentice mechanic tool expense is increased to \$1,000
- O Digital subscription receipts for qualified Canadian journalism organization (to maximum of \$500)
